





Since our last newsletter, a public meeting was held December 16th at which time:


- A) over 96% of those in attendance favoured a change in our mailing address from Navan to Orleans East and,

ARE YOU PAYING TO MUCH IN PROPERTY TAXES

When we moved here from Queenswood Heights last summer, I sold my home for \$105K and was paying around \$1200 in property taxes. My new home cost 34% more yet my taxes have increased by 225%. Why such a large increase? Could the assessor of erred? Who should I speak to ? How do I go about having it reviewed?

If you have similar questions, plan on attending the 'Property Tax Update' which will be held on Thursday January 15th. Representatives from the 'Regional Assessment Office' and the 'Assessment Review Board' have agreed to be at our meeting and will try to answer the above questions and any others that you might have.
