During the past three months, the crime rate was down but there are still too many incidents that need not have happened. I am referring to thefts from unlocked cars and "forced-entry" into homes with unlocked doors. Please don't become a victim of an unforced and unnecessary crime. That horrible feeling of invasion of one's property and privacy is an experience no one should be required to endure.

Tips for a Safe Summer

- Keep all doors and windows including the patio door and garage door locked when you are away from the home (crimes take place in minutes but require a long long time to get over).

- If you plan to be away from your home for an extended period of time, get a trusted neighbour to pick up your mail and newspapers, cut the grass and in general give your home a "lived-in" appearance. Why not have the neighbour park their car in your driveway.

- Have a safe and happy summer.
