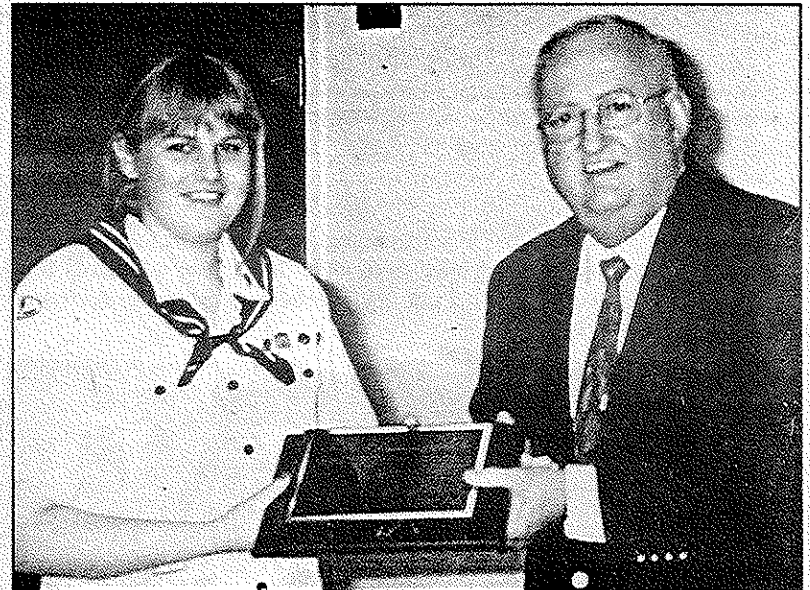

Pooch Park Poop Pickup

As part of Ottawa's "Spring Cleaning the Capital" program, a group of dogowners in Fallingbrook banded together to scoop the poop in Fallingbrook Park. They spent a Sunday morning removing what had accumulated during the winter.

The cleanup crew points out that 99 percent of dog owners are conscientious about cleaning up after their dogs. The remaining 1 percent give the rest of the owners a bad reputation. One dog, pooping once a day over the winter, will leave 100 steaming piles by the spring. Someone pointed out that this behaviour can be discouraged by rubbing the owner's nose in it.



Local Teens Organize Music Event

A group of Fallingbrook teens have been hard at work arranging a festival to showcase their musical talents to other teens. Springfest 2001 was the brainchild of local indie recording artists, Bad Mojo.

The band, which has performed at numerous events such as SuperEx, the Fallingbrook Canada Day Celebration, and on Rogers Television, wanted to continue playing for their growing fan base. The members of the group have been looking for venues to perform their music, which are limited. Most clubs are subject to Ontario laws prohibiting minors from performing where liquor is being served, and club owners usually won't open their business to an all ages show. (under 19)

After discussing the situation with other local artists, it was decided to organize an event where they could perform for their peers right in Orleans.

This year the show will feature five bands, Bad Mojo, Easily Distracted and Pandemonium, plus Dunny's Own and Mannie and the Swingin' Hipshakers. Bad Mojo and a second band performed to a sold out crowd, at a similar event last year. The success of this year's show, could decide whether it will become an annual event.

Springfest 2001 has been designed to give youth from Orleans a place where they can enjoy a live musical performance, without having to venture out of their neighbourhood. The event will also allow local bands to showcase their talents to an expanded audience.

The event will be held at the Ray Friel Center, 1585 Tenth Line Road on Saturday, 26 May 2001, 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Admission is \$5.00 and tickets are limited. For further information call 834-9677 or 834-0227.

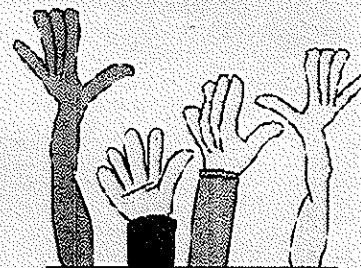

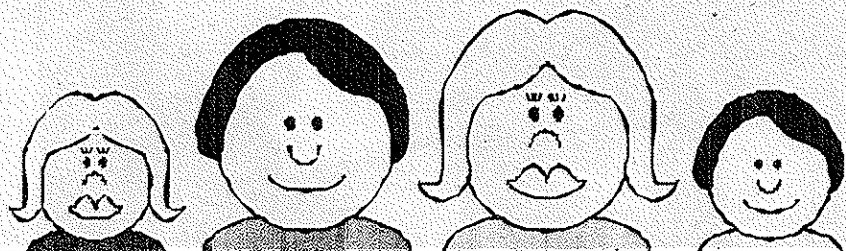
