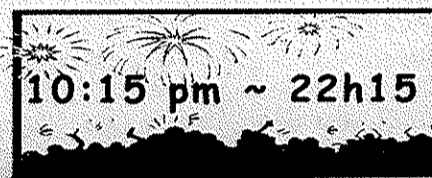

Possible New Arenas at Ray Friel Centre

City staff have been given the green light by the corporate services and economic development committee to enter into negotiations with Serco Facilities Management for the construction of two new east-end arenas. Serco is the private company responsible for management of the Ray Friel Centre, under contract to the city.

The start of negotiations with Serco is the next step in the city's Private-Public Partnership, or P3, initiative to overcome a shortage of ice surfaces in all regions of Ottawa. Under a potential deal Serco will provide the financing for the construction of the new east-end arenas, while the city commits to 2,400 hours annually of prime time ice rentals. With projected budget deficits expected to have a major impact on city-financed capital projects, the P3 approach to service delivery must be seriously considered. Similarly, the construction of two new arenas at the Ray Friel Centre could cause disruption to Fallingbrook residents if issues such as traffic and parking are not properly dealt with.

Orléans Ward Councillor Herb Kreling promises that the process will be open and transparent (see article below). Public meetings will be held to solicit community feedback on the proposal, and to keep everyone up-to-date on what is happening. **The Fallingbrook Community Association encourages you to participate.**

- 6,000 square feet of recreation and community programming; and
- Expanded parking facilities.

As part of the Public-Private Partnership (P3) initiative, the City of Ottawa and Serco Facilities Management Inc. (Serco) are currently exploring a proposal to expand the existing Ray Friel Centre. After evaluating incoming proposals, Serco was selected as the partner in the provision of ice surfaces in the east end of the City. All parties involved are committed to a public, transparent process.

Open House Agenda

Concept plans for the potential expansion will be available to view.
Presentation and discussion regarding the impact of the expansion on local traffic.
Public Consultation.
Opportunities for questions to representatives from partner groups.

The City and Serco Facilities Management are currently negotiating an agreement for the expansion of the Ray Friel Centre and are committed to a public, transparent process.

What does it mean to you?

A public-private sector partnership (P3) is a contractual agreement between the City and a for-profit corporation in which the skills, resources and assets of the partners are shared in providing a service or facility.

Your participation makes a difference in ensuring your issues are addressed. Please join us on July 3, 2003 to discuss the proposed ice surface expansion. Staff will be available to answer questions and assist you with understanding the public-private partnership.

This will be the first of two public sessions. A second public meeting will be arranged in August of 2003 to review final negotiated arrangements for the Ray Friel Centre.

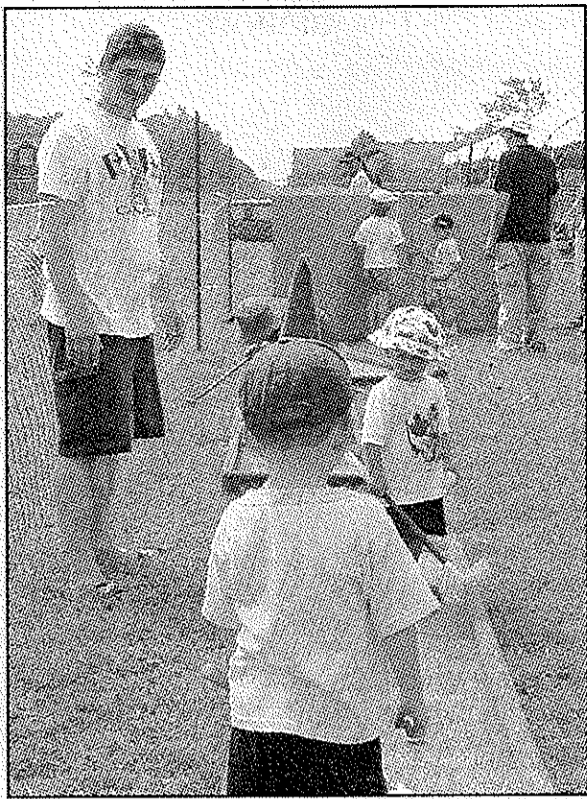

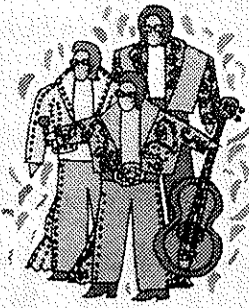

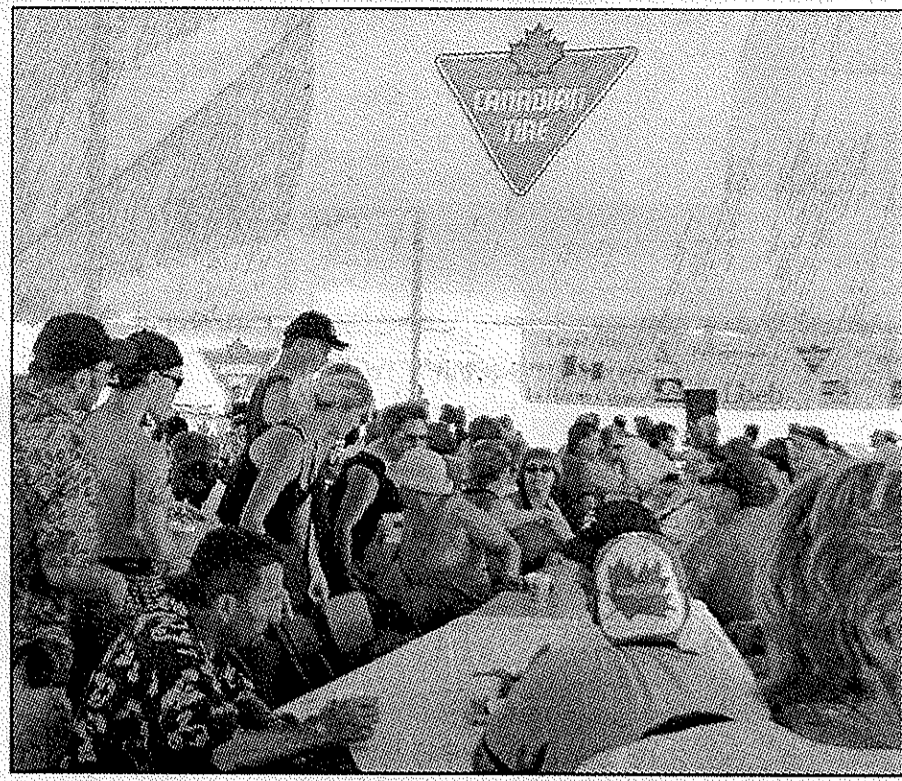
