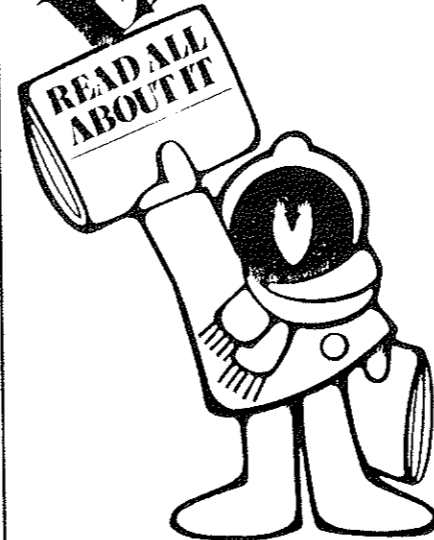

My how things change! In just three years we have gone from an empty field to a dynamic, vibrant community of over 6,000 people.

With our annual general meeting coming up May 5th now is a time to reflect on our past accomplishments and look towards the future. This years accomplishments include:

a) lobbying for and winning the right to use Orleans as our mailing address.

b) organizing community events such as; Crater Bash, the Crocus Caper, two 'Get to Know Your Neighbor' dances, Christmas Carolling and participation in Mayfair to name but a few.

c) presenting to the deputy minister of transport in Toronto a brief on the proposed tenth line/ highway 17 interchange. Support was sought and received from the township, neighboring community associations, and our MPP Jean Poirier.

d) lobbying for improved bus service. A well attended public meeting with O.C. Transpo regarding bus service was also organized.

e) applying for and receiving funding from the township to build and operate two outdoor ice surfaces this past winter.

f) the realization of our first park '**Des Pionnier**' and the soon to be completed **Fallingbrook Community Centre and Park** off Princess Louise Drive.

g) developing a close rapport with the township and effectively communicating residents concerns (ie. everything from truck traffic to snow removal on certain pathways).

h) this newsletter which continues to inform residents on what's happening in their community.

The above are but some of the associations accomplishments. I would like to encourage all residents to get involved even if its only by buying a membership and attending the associations annual general meeting May 5th.

Come out and encourage the many volunteers who make Fallingbrook the vibrant, active community it has become.
